Leadership Team Updates

- PTA/SLT
- Leadership team huddle on 2/5/14 - PTA did agree to consider the 2.5 teachers actual salary in their budget. Lowest paid teach salaries - about \$112,000. Saves the budget about \$38,000. (go auction committee!)
- Budget Paras for same number of hours right now and then see if we can raise that.
- Also dedicate auction paddle raiser for the computer lab. Goal is \$30K.

Review Superintendent's update re budget -

Won't get Title II money of \$20 per student - district trying to backfill that. (Title II used for professional development)

Increase of \$40 per pupil / Instructional dollars stays the same / Same stipend for Guest Teachers and substitutes / Same \$400 per ELL student that tests eligible for the money / Free and Reduced lunch Supplemental stays the same as \$461 per eligible students. / \$120 per HG/HGT student plus .25 for GT coordinator / 2012 Mill Levy Tech funds - \$50 per student
