Discussion Items

Agenda Item #:1	SPF (School Performance Framework)
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Options/Points Raised:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Joan went over the SPF and discussed how the school is performing. Overall the school is performing well and progressing where it needs to. Some kids are struggling with writing, spelling, phonics. Teachers want more PD for these areas to help meet kids needs The current investment in PD (Professional Development) seems to be paying dividends as needed for MATH.
Decision or Recommendations:	Joan is looking into more Orton Gillingham PD for teachers to help improve areas where kids are struggling.
Agenda Item #2:	Traffic Safety
Options/Points Raised:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Joan is aware and concerned for pedestrian safety during drop off and pick up from auto traffic. We discussed the potential for more traffic features, Police presence, and other ways to encourage safe driving. Joan has emailed the city to request help regulating unsafe traffic
Decision or Recommendations:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Joan has sent out parent posts reminding parents of proper traffic procedures and will continue. CSC members will also reach out to the city regarding the potential for more safety regulations for Cory/C3/Merril.
Agenda Item #3:	Facilities Update
Options/Points Raised:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> CSC met with the members of DPS facility staff to discuss Cory's temperatures. We established that the best option until further money is available for DPS to continue major improvements in schools without AC (a bond) would be to make our current system as efficient as possible. Joan and CSC will set up annual trainings for parents and staff of the facilities current ventilation system to ensure efficient use. Opportunities for improvements to the system would be through Haiku fans and porta coolers. DPS is going to research the current school electricity capacity for how many coolers and fans we can buy.
Decision or Recommendations:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> CSC will continue to work with DPS on ways to maintain safe temperatures, make what we have work to its best ability, cooperate on master plan for future bond allocations. CSC will work with DPS too find out how many Porta coolers we need to buy CSC will work with DPS on installing Haiku fans in classrooms
