Presentation and data

- Equitable Math Instruction
 - o Believe that your student can understand grade-level math
 - Create multiple points of entry into math problems
 - Cultivate a deeper understanding of math
- Shifting from compacted to more clustered heterogeneous groupings
- How?- This is the process our 4/5 math team followed this year
 - Data driven instruction
 - Hands on, real world experiences- entry points
 - Growth mindset instruction
- Experiences this year
 - Positive
 - Closer class communities
 - Rich math conversations
 - Increased collaboration
 - Flexibility in the math block
 - Differentiation, goal setting, purposeful pacing
 - Additional instructional time for math and science (w/ less class transitions)
- Data
 - Community input
 - insufficient data
 - High growth in some areas
 - Proficiency vs. growth data
 - Math Mindset Survey
 - 2023-I am challenged in math (43.9%)
 - 2024- I am challenged in math (82.7%)
 - How are students interpreting "challenged"
- Plans for next year
 - Tiered grouping for guided math 1-2x per week
 - Additional differentiated tasks
 - Collaboration among like-minded peers
 - push -in support from SSPs
 - Project based learning
 - Increased equity within classroom placements
 - IXL tech support

Community Input

- Want more data
 - Strands of data, groups of students, sub group data
- What do we need to look at to get the full picture?

- GT input- gifted learners should be a year and a half growth
- Opportunity for parent voice (survey for parents)
 - How can we better educate families about what is happening in the classroom?
 - o CSC parent shares student's experience- positive mindset around her math ability
 - What does the differentiation look like in the classroom? Name the differentiation moves to support student access.
 - Incorporate above grade level opportunities the scope and sequence that names the differentiation
- Motivation within the new math model?- students that thrive off of competition
- How can we demonstrate that students are being challenged?
