- Neighborhood Boundary School with Highly Gifted and Talented Programming -

The following information is used to enroll students using DPS’s SchoolChoice student assignment process and is subject to change. Some exceptions may exist in alignment with Colorado state law and DPS Board of Education policies.

Denver Public Schools makes every attempt to accommodate siblings who apply together in the same school year. A separate SchoolChoice application must be submitted for each sibling to be considered.

Applicants who live in Denver and have a sibling who currently attends or will attend the school next year 5. Applicants whose parent/guardian is a full-time staff member at this school 6. Applicants who reside in Denver, <u>AND</u> qualify for HGT, <u>AND</u> have a sibling who currently attends or will attend the school next year
