COVID Protocols

Should we increase safety measures and protocols?

The safety measures we are implementing now.

- Requiring students to wear masks outside before/ after school, at recess and PE new
- Mask breaks will be cohorted to classrooms no intermixing during this time- new
- Requiring families to wear masks at arrival and dismissal new
- Requiring students to wear masks after eating lunch and sitting at least 6 ft apart while masks are off
- Prioritizing students to eat lunch and snack outside at all times- if the weather is too bad, snacks will be skipped. If the weather is too wet or cold, we will follow our indoor lunch plan (students will be sitting 6 ft. apart, have masks off for only 14 mins, and dividers at tables) The indoor lunch spaces will be the cafeteria, auditorium, and gym/library.
- Students who struggle wearing a mask will get support from our admin staff to educate and provide a new mask. If mask wearing continues to be a problem, we will partner with families to provide the support and provide students a divider to support safety. Students must have masks that fit them properly and have multiple masks in their backpack.
- Frequent hand washing and sanitizing (walkthroughs to ensure bathrooms are clean and have soap/paper towels).
- At this time, there is no strict cohorting or restrictions with students moving classrooms, but this could change.
