4. PRINCIPAL UPDATE - Joan Wieser

- New Cory Website
 - Images to be updated
 - Doesn't currently appear to be mobile-friendly Is there a way to address this?

- Shared Campus Update
 - In a bit of a holding pattern, although one goal is to bring Kindergarten back to Cory this is being considered as part of 2020 bond.
 - Joan will send a follow-up email clarifying that Cory is not being considered to move locations, despite Shared Campus email being a bit unclear
- Cory's 2020-2021 budget is complete
 - Increasing GT time to support the integrated model (increase from 0.5 to 0.65) next year
 - Increasing Professional Development from the Public Education & Business Coalition (PEBC) to support literacy and math next year
 - Support lesson studies for grade levels A strategic way for teachers to collaborate around lessons

- Lesson study this week and next week to support rigor, student agency, productive struggle and quality feedback

6. BUDGET - Kristine Hawthorne for Debbie Fimple

- We are tracking according to projections on budget
- The \$10,000 donation that was discussed during Friends of Cory (from a specific organization and to be dedicated to a specific project) did not come to fruition; however, the organization still decided to donate \$4000 to the general Friends of Cory drive
- Mini-grants are available, but teachers need to be applying for these
 - Stephanie Campbell volunteered to work with teachers to fill out the applications

7. MISCELLANEOUS

- Edukit Jennifer Grumann
 - We are working with the Edukit point person to be less wasteful many ideas to accomplish this
 - Option to purchase new headsets each year
 - Possibly keeping certain reusable supplies (scissors, etc.) in the grade levels
 - Exploring more sustainable/less expensive supply options (erasers, pencils, sharpeners, composition notebooks, etc.)
 - Jennifer Grumann will work with Joan and the teachers
 - Possibly donate gently used/excess supplies to other schools at the end of the year
- Concert on the Green Concerns with the proposed May 29 date, exact date and time to be confirmed soon
- Broader family involvement in the PTA/CSC
 - PTA Happy Hour held on January 23 Not many new faces
 - Scot Kreider suggested contacting people via phone if we are looking to reach more attendees, volunteers, etc.
 - Possibly ask for a preferred method of communication during next year's membership drive?
- Ongoing Facilities/Maintenance Concerns
 - PTA Board has heard concerns that PTA purchased items are not being properly maintained - these concerns have been shared with Joan and with Patricia Montoya (facilities manager for Cory)

- There are policies and procedures that must be followed pursuant to DPS, including the submission of work orders This process is not always quick
