2022-23 SchoolChoice Priorities
Neighborhood Boundary School

The following information will be used to prioritize applicants during the SchoolChoice student assignment process, as approved by the DPS Board of Education.

Applicants for Kindergarten are prioritized in the following way (at Stephen Knight Center):

1. Students who reside in the school boundary (guaranteed in Round 1 only)
2. District resident students with a sibling admitted at the school
3. Children of full-time employees at the school
4. District resident students who are currently attending the school's 4-year-old ECE program
5. All other District resident students
6. Non-District resident students who are currently attending the school's 4-year-old ECE program **or** have a sibling admitted at the school
7. All other non-District resident students

Applicants for grades 1 – 5 are prioritized in the following way:

1. Students who reside in the school boundary (guaranteed in Round 1 only) **or** District resident students who are currently attending the school
2. Students eligible for the Highly Gifted and Talented program who reside in the Highly Gifted and Talented feeder school zone with a sibling admitted at the school (see chart below)
3. Students eligible for the Highly Gifted and Talented program who reside in the District with a sibling admitted at the school
4. Students eligible for the Highly Gifted and Talented program who reside in the Highly Gifted and Talented feeder school zone (see chart below)
5. District resident students with a sibling admitted at the school
6. Students eligible for the Highly Gifted and Talented program who reside in the District
7. Children of full-time employees at the school
8. District resident students currently impacted by school closure decisions
9. All other District resident students
10. Non-District students who are eligible for the Highly Gifted and Talented program and have a sibling admitted at the school
11. Non-District students who are eligible for the Highly Gifted and Talented program
12. Non-District resident students who are currently attending the school **or** have a sibling admitted at the school



- 13. Non-District resident students currently impacted by school closure decisions
- 14. All other non-district resident students
